the County of Bucks and Commonwealth of Pennsylva-
nia Store keeper have and do for Myself my heirs
Exors, and Admors Manumate and set free my Negroe
Slave nam'd Esther about Twenty three years of
Age, and I do hereby for myself my heirs, Exors
and Admors resign and give up all my right
Title and Interest to the said Negroe Esther
from the Day of the Date hereof of these Pre-
sents Agreeably to an Act of Assembly of this
Commonwealth passed at Philadelphia the
first day of March In the year of our Lord
One thousand seven hundred and Eighty Enti-
tled an Act for the gradual Abolition of Slavery
As Witness my hand and Seal this Twenty third
day of May In the year of our Lord One thousand
seven hundred and Eighty seven
