Thomas Hard of Connerset-township, enters of records, a negro male child named Andrew, born on the seventh day of August last past, of the body of Rachel, a negro slave until the age of twenty eight years.

Jane Sweetman widow, of Hollowfield township in the County of Washington, desires the Clerk of the peace of said County to enter of records a negro male child named George Perry born the first day of September last of the body of Anne a negro slave until the age of twenty eight years. Given under my hands the 25<sup>th</sup> day of February 1809.
