Elyah Pilston - free negro - aged about 26 years - reside  
at John Blanford - came from Virginia - arrived in  
Lancaster 8 days ago - Labourer - entered April 18 1828

John Parsons - free negro aged about 30 years reside  
in Middle Street - came to Lancaster about 9 months ago.  
Labourer - Entered May 28 1828.

Mary Bafite light coloured Mulatto, a widow, aged  
about 29 years, at Thomas Sharp, in Adams Town.  
Entered June 19 1828

Richard Ringold Negro man, about 55 years of age  
in Mufson Town - a Labourer - Entered Nov 7 1828

Samuel Brown, Mulatto aged 44 years, a Labourer  
resides in Mufson Town in East Street house. Entd Nov 8 1828

Lavin Green - Negro - aged 20, a Dutchess by trade  
resides in Adams Town - a wife + 3 children entd Nov 24 1828

Dani Ralph Negro - aged about 22 years Labourer  
resides in Adams Town with Lavin Green from Baltimore  
D. Dec 13 1828

Benjamin Ralph Negro - aged at 23 years, Labourer  
resides in Adams Town with Lavin Green.  
Entd Dec 13 1828

John Hudson Negro - aged - 25 years - Labourer  
resides with Lavin Green in East King Street,  
Entered April 23 1829

Middletown Coley light coloured negro - aged 29 years  
Plasterer, resides in South Queen Street, wife named Mary.  
Entered June 3 1829

Timothy Volentin, black man - about 23 years of age. Single-  
man - raised in Keyett County - at Dr. Moore's laborer -  
Entered July 27 1822

Phuelin Hoats, yellow man - about 29 years of age. has  
a wife and two children - Shoemaker by trade - from Richmond  
Virginia - bound at James Melton -  
Entered Aug 27 1822.

27<sup>th</sup> 1822  
Isaac Gilmore, enters his two Apprentices to Sweeping Chimneys,  
the one named Jacob Patterson, yellow, 16 years of Age, then Alexander  
Pompey, yellow, about 8 years of age -  
entered Sept 25 1822.

27<sup>th</sup> 1822  
Isaac Gilmore, enters his <sup>third</sup> boy - for sweeping Chimneys, named  
Edward Morgan, came from Columbia - near 18 years years of  
age -  
Entered October 3 1822.

Henry Jordan, black boy, aged about 20 years, Apprentice to James  
Johnston to learn Chimney sweeping - entered by his said Master  
the 20<sup>th</sup> day of October 1822.

John Price, black, mulatto, aged about 19 years - Apprentice to Benjamin  
Johnston - Chimney sweeper - entered by his said Master, the 20<sup>th</sup> Oct,  
1822

John Brown, black boy aged about 19 years, raised in Chester County,  
water - live with Johna Scott - entered December 3 1822.

Charles Green, black boy about 16 years of age, raised in Chester County  
water - live with J. H. Franklin - entered December 3 1822.
