C. V. Henry was born in Annville, Lebanon Co., May 23, 1865, died (?). He was secretary to Robert H. Coleman of Cornwall in the 1890's and district attorney, 1901-1904. Governor Stuart appointed him president judge of the Court of Common Pleas (Lebanon County, Fifty-second Judicial District) in June 1910. He was elected as Judge in 1911 and served until January 1942. In 1928 he was elected as a delegate to the Republican National Convention. C.V. Henry was appointed Standing Master on the Board of Governance of the Pennsylvania Bar on January 21, 1942 and retired from the Board in 1947. He was President of the Lebanon National Bank from 1933-1953 and Chairman of the Board of Directors from 1953. He had two children, Mary Albertsen and C. V. Henry, Jr. (See MG-182 for records while he was employed by Coleman).
