On account of ill health he was honorably discharged of his own free will and choice without claim for pension. He is leaving the army well recommended as a trustworthy honorable man. Certified by the Commander of his Battailon in Cassel, 18 May 1816

Application for Guardianship : Referring to the request of Adam ZUNDEL, legally approved guardian of his minor children, Christine and Christoph Zundel, concerning their maternal estate located in Rambach, the court is granting guardianship of the property to the guardian, if all the maternal relatives of his deceased wife, Anna Elisabeth Boettger, or, in case of their inability to appear, all the relatives of the guardian, will be present testify to the usefulness of a sale, or disposal, so that the revenues therefrom will be secured for the children of the deceased mother. Issued Court House in Wannfried, 11 June 1840

Inventory of Estate: Adam Zundel, guardian for his children, Anna Christina, 9 yrs old and Christoph, 1 year 3 months old, after the death of his wife Anna Elisabeth Boettger, has complied with the request of giving an Inventory of the estate left to his children by the deceased, as follows:
 A farmhouse and stable, with pasture, near the schoolhouse, gardenhouse, with surrounding garden, (location discribed)
furniture: a plane in storehouse, garden implement, taxed: 106 Mks.
Clothing: taxed: Mks 120.-
 Sworn to and confirmed Rambach, 20 Apr 1838, Wannfried, 3 May 1838

Pass of emigration: All civil and military bodies are being requested to let the labore: Adam ZUNDEL and his 2 children, a girl of 10½ years old and a boy, 3 yrs. 9 months old, all of Rambach, pass through any territory free and protected for their emigration to North America. Eschwege, 15 July 1840
