Copies of outgoing correspondence of Edward Camphausen (1823-1903), Erie attorney and United States consul in Naples, 1885[6]-1890; Correspondence, mainly press copies but some written copies, contained in three letterpress books; subjects discussed included legal business prior to Camphausen's departure for Naples, consular business in Naples and the climate there, the prospect of his return to Erie following the Democratic defeat in the 1888 election, the health of his family and friends, the quality of his successors at the consulate in Naples, his interest in obtaining another appointment after the Democrats' 1892 Presidential victory, and political developments on the local scene; a number of the letters are written in German and a few in other languages.
