Diesel Electric Locomotives

In 1940 the Baldwin Locomotive Works introduced a
consolidated, three volume "Drawing Directory." This apparently

was used to keep track of new drawings made by both the steam and electric divisions after that date. Drawing numbers were to have three elements: first, the group (or type of item) numbered from 1 to 99; second, the size number from 1 (11x8.5") to 7 (normally so long that it was stored as a roll); and third, the sequential drawing number in that group and size. Starting in 1975 the Baldwin-Hamilton Company started to donate the steam locomotive drawings listed in the "Drawing Directory." With a few exceptions, the drawings that remain in the BHC collection are uniquely diesel electric or were common to both types of locomotives.

Addenda "The Baldwin Locomotive Works -- Drawing Directory", three volumes, 14.5"x17.75"; post-binder, leather covered boards with metal edges; interior page size, 13"x17", c. 500 sheets and 1000 pages each; some soiling from constant use, but generally in good condition. Not all pages, however, were used; apparently the volumes were laid out in advance. Most groups -- from 1 to 99 -- were given pages for all seven drawing sizes; being post-binder books pages could be added as needed but the original, unused pages were not removed to make room.

Volume one contains groups 1 to 49, "drawing office system" to "gauges, templates" [the groups follow a rough alphabetical order starting at 11 with "axles"]; volume two, 50 to 79, "guides" to "steam gauge, safety valve turrets"; volume three, 80 to 99, "steam pipes, superheater" to "miscellaneous" .

Each page is identified on top with group title, corresponding group number and drawing size. Below on the page there are two, vertical sections with space to register 120 drawings. Each section has five columns: drawing number, sub-title [name of specific part within the group], order, date, and initial [of draftsman]. All drawing numbers end in a zero thus 11-4-260 is the 26th drawing -- a motor truck axle -- which was drawn on 10-21-52.
