The papers of the Elder family of Dauphin County. They are mainly legal papers of Thomas Elder (b. 1767, d. 1853), a Dauphin County lawyer from 1791 and Attorney General of Penna. from 1820-23. The papers also include deeds and correspondence. Other family members represented are Joshua Elder (b. 1744/5, d. 1820), a prothonotary from 1800-1810; Samuel Elder (b. 1772, d. 1815), High Sherrif of Dauphin County from 1800-1803.

Photostats, including Rev. John Elder, were transferred to the History Division.
