of Joseph Boon on the Grampian hills on the plantation of  
this deponent - the said Negro woman being a servant for  
twenty eight years unto the said Joseph Boon - the oldest of  
the said Negro children is named Valentine and the youngest  
Orson - the woman is married to a Negro man of the Henry C. P. Co.
