month of September 1806 of negro Chloe a slave until she
arrives at the age of twenty eight years.

Mary Dodd of the town of Washington, widow enters of records a
male negro child named John, born the ninth day of October,
in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and five
of the body of Lydia a negro woman, a slave for life.
