

KENNEDY AND STOWE — TOWNSHIPS — ALLEGHENY COUNTY

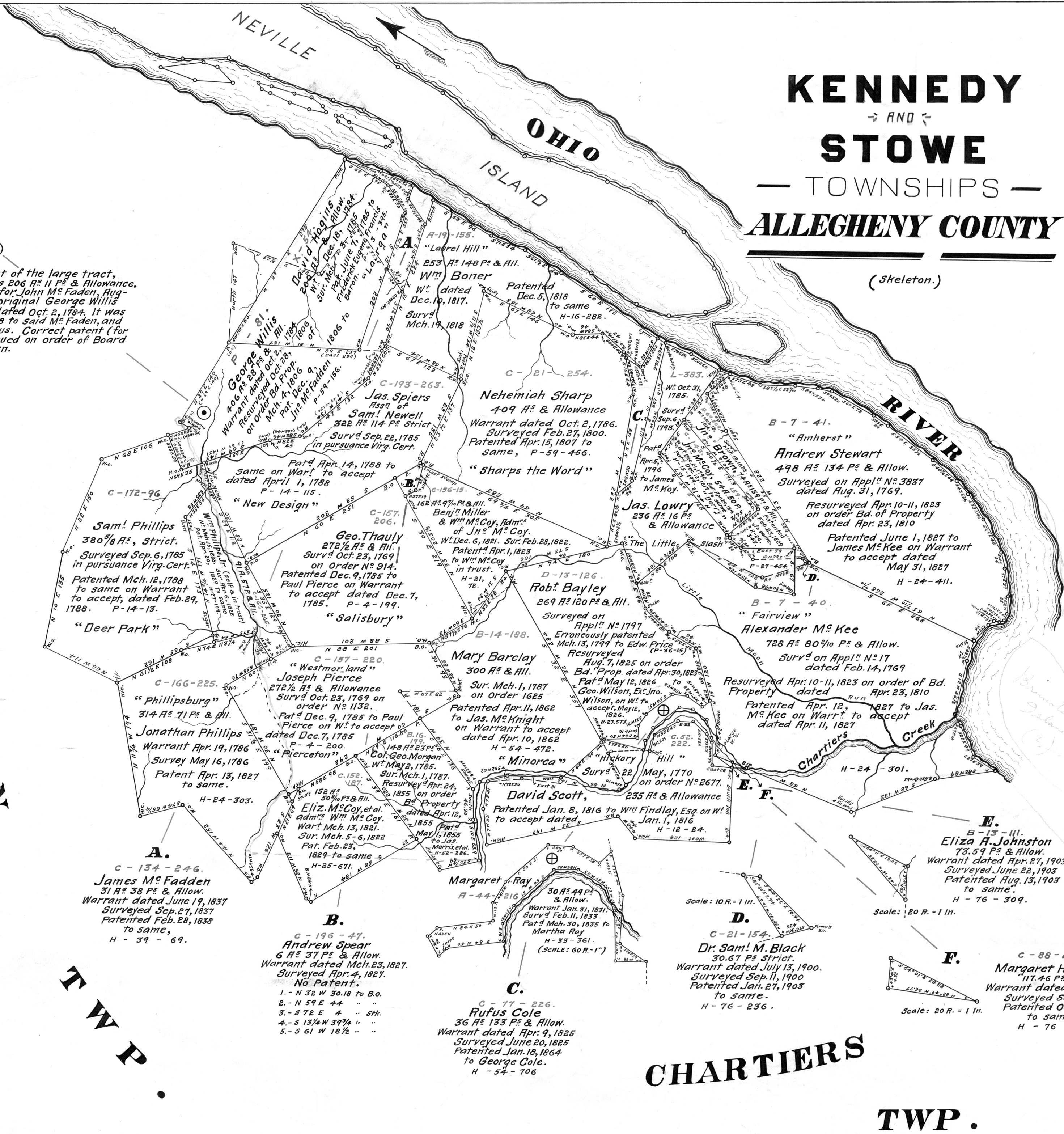
(Skeleton.)

It was patented July 26, 1788 to said M^c Faden, and found to be erroneous. Correct patent (for large tract) then issued on order of Board of Property as shown.
