 THE TOP OF BERRY MOUNTAIN RUNS IN AN EAST WEST DIRECTION, THRU THE TRACTS NUMBERED 17, 22, 23, 24, 28, 29. THE TRACTS SHOWN ON THE NORTH AND SOUTH FACE OF BERRY MOUNTAIN HAVE BEEN ADJUSTED ON THE DRAWING TO COMPENSATE FOR THE UP HILL CHAINED DISTANCES ON BOTH FACES OF THE MOUNTAIN, WHICH WERE NOT REDUCED TO HORIZONTAL DISTANCES BY THE SURVEYORS OF OLD. THE AMOUNT OF REDUCTION HAS BEEN DETERMINED BY THE INTERSECTION OF ANGLES OF THE EAST - WEST SURVEY LINES. IF THIS HAD NOT BEEN DONE, THIS DRAFT WOULD BE IMPOSSIBLE TO CONNECT ON A FLAT PLANE DRAWING, AS ILLUSTRATED ON AN EARLIER DRAWING DATED MARCH 10th 1822. THE 33 TRACTS (INCLUDING SPLITS) INVOLVED IN THIS CONNECTED DRAFT WERE SURVEYED OVER A PERIOD OF 87 YEARS, FROM 1765 TO 1852. THESE SURVEYS WERE PERFORMED BY 10 DIFFERENT SURVEYORS, 8 DEPUTY SURVEYORS FROM THE LAND OFFICE AND 2 DAUPHIN COUNTY SURVEYORS.

A CONNECTED DRAFT of thirty-three (33) tracts of land, which when surveyed, were situate as follows: fifteen (15) in Upper Paxton Township, Dauphin County; twelve (12) in Paxton Township, Lancaster (now Dauphin) County; three (3) in Upper Paxton and Halifax Townships, Dauphin County; two (2) in Halifax Township, Dauphin County; one (1) in Upper Paxton Township Lancaster (now Dauphin) County. The draft has been constructed from and compared with the original drafts on file in the Division Of Land Records, Bureau Of Archives And History, Historical And Museum Commission, Commonwealth Of Pennsylvania, under the direction of Edward D. Price, Chief.
