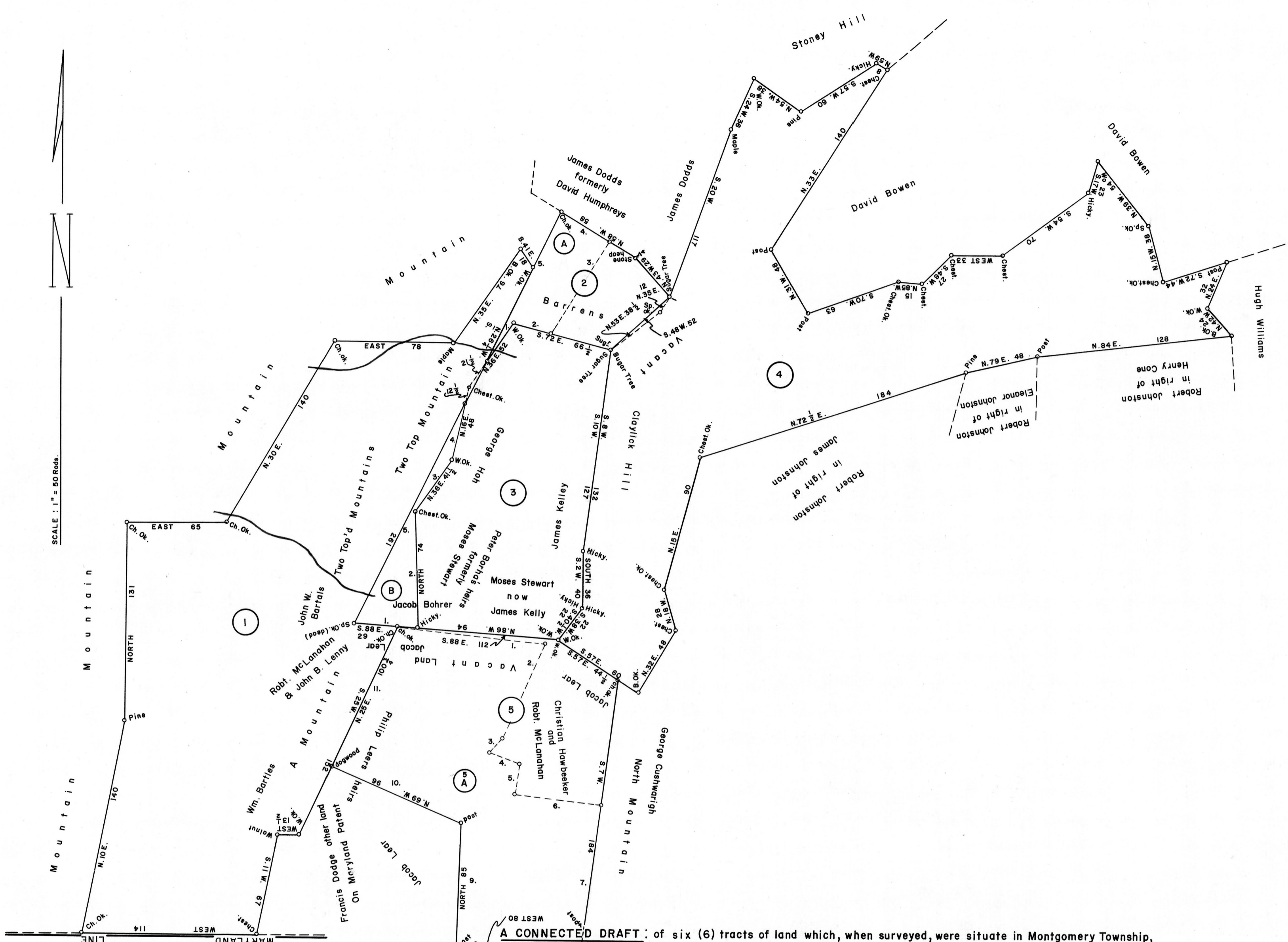


SCALE: 1" = 80 Rods.
