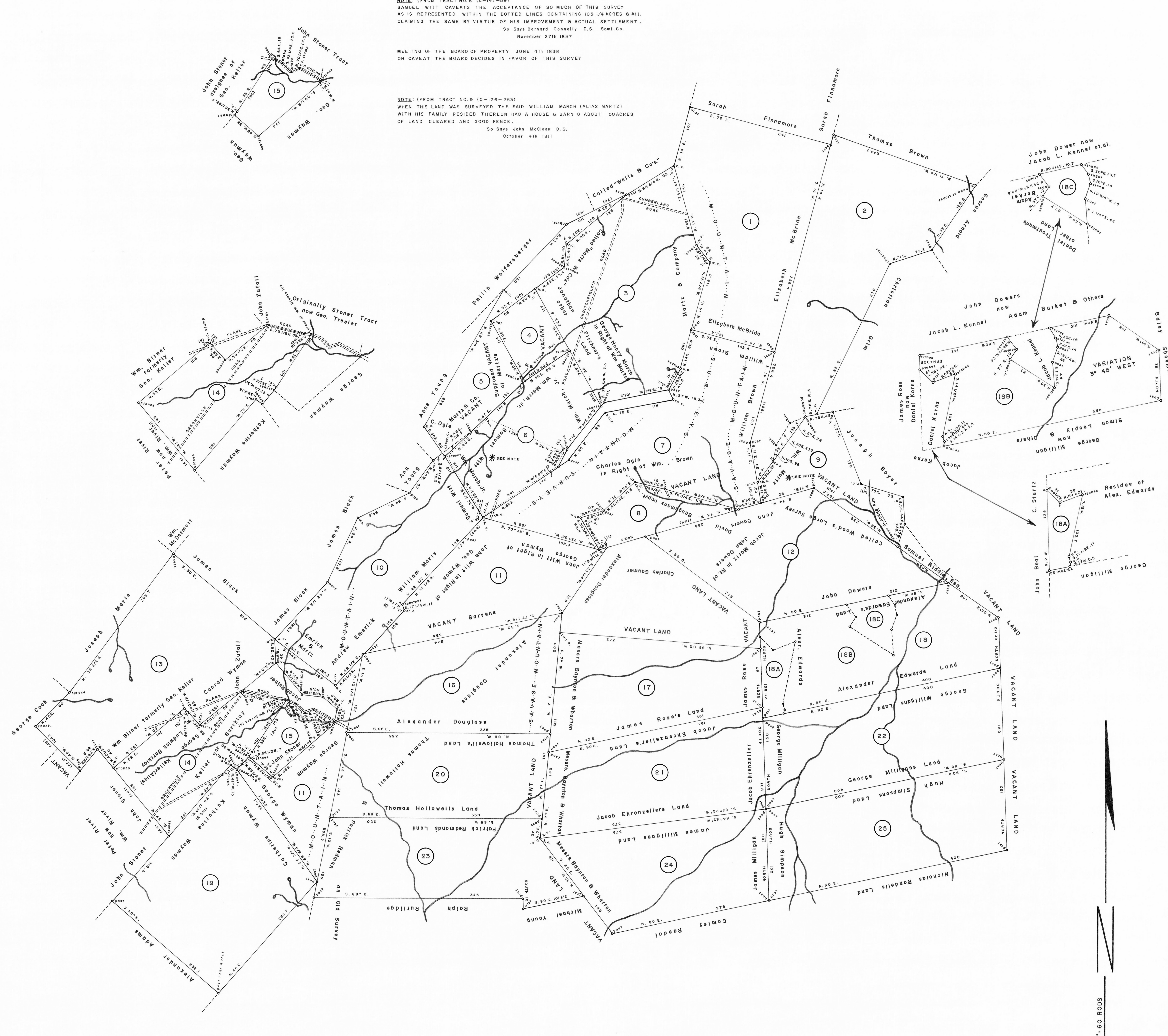

MEETING OF THE BOARD OF PROPERTY JUNE 4th 1838
ON CAVEAT THE BOARD DECIDES IN FAVOR OF THIS SURVEY

NOTE: (FROM TRACT NO. 9 (C-136-263))
WHEN THIS LAND WAS SURVEYED THE SAID WILLIAM MARCH (ALIAS MARTZ) WITH HIS FAMILY RESIDED THEREON HAD A HOUSE & BARN & ABOUT 50 ACRES OF LAND CLEARED AND GOOD FENCE.

October 4th 1811

NOTE: THE TRACT OF LAND IN QUESTION (TRACT NO. 11 Called "Confusion") WARRANTED TO GEORGE WYMAN ON JULY 19th 1793 AND SHOWN ON MAIN MAP. THIS TRACT COULD NOT BE COMPLETELY SURROUNDED BY ADJOINING TRACTS, ON THE NORTHEAST SIDE OF TRACT NO. 11 A LARGE SHADED AREA IS SHOWN. THIS AREA CANNOT BE ACCOUNTED FOR BY THE BUREAU OF LAND RECORDS BECAUSE NO WARRANT OR SURVEY HAS BEEN FOUND BY THIS OFFICE. THE AREA WAS CALLED VACANT BY THE ADJOINERS SHOWN ON THE SURVEYS FOR TRACTS NO. 12, 17 & 18. THE SURVEY FOR TRACT NO. 7 CALLED ALEXANDER DOUGLASS AND THE SURVEY FOR TRACT NO. 8 CALLED CHARLES GAUMER (AS SHOWN). THE SAME APPLIES FOR THE SMALLER SHADED AREA SHOWN ON THE SOUTHWEST SIDE OF TRACT NO. 11 THIS AREA BEING CALLED TO JACOB REIBER FOR THE SURVEY FOR TRACT NO. 10. A THIRD AREA IS ALSO SHOWN SHADED TO THE NORTH OF TRACT NO. 11 WITH NO CALLS FROM ADJOINING SURVEYS.

A PORTION OF THE NORTHWEST SIDE OF TRACT NO. 9 OVERLAPS ONTO TRACT NO. 2. ALSO THE NORTHERN POINT OF TRACT NO. 10 OVERLAPS ONTO TRACT NO. 5.

THESE 28 TRACTS (25 AND A SPLIT TRACT OF 3-28 TOTAL) WERE SURVEYED OUT OVER A PERIOD OF 140 YEARS (1767 TO 1907) BY EIGHT DIFFERENT SURVEYORS.

A CONNECTED DRAFT: of twenty-eight (28) tracts of land, which when surveyed, were situate as follows: six (6) in Londonderry Township, Bedford (now Somerset) County; twelve (12) in Southampton Township, Somerset County; ten (10) in Cumberland (now Somerset) County. The draft has been constructed from and compared with the original drafts on file in the Bureau of Land Records, Department of Community Affairs, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, under the direction of Edward D. Price, Director.
