

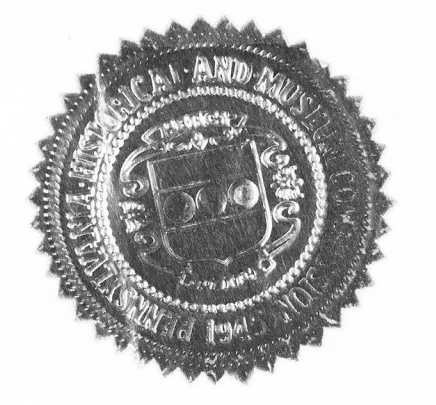

**A CONNECTED DRAFT.** of twenty (20) tracts of land, which when surveyed, were situate as follows: three (3) in Quemahoning Township, Bedford (now Somerset) County; twelve (12) in Napier Township, Bedford County; four (4) in Shade Township, Somerset County; and one (1) in Bedford Township, Bedford County. The draft has been constructed from and compared with original drafts on file in the Division of Land Records, Bureau of Archives and History, Historical and Museum Commission, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, under the direction of Edward D. Price, Chief.
