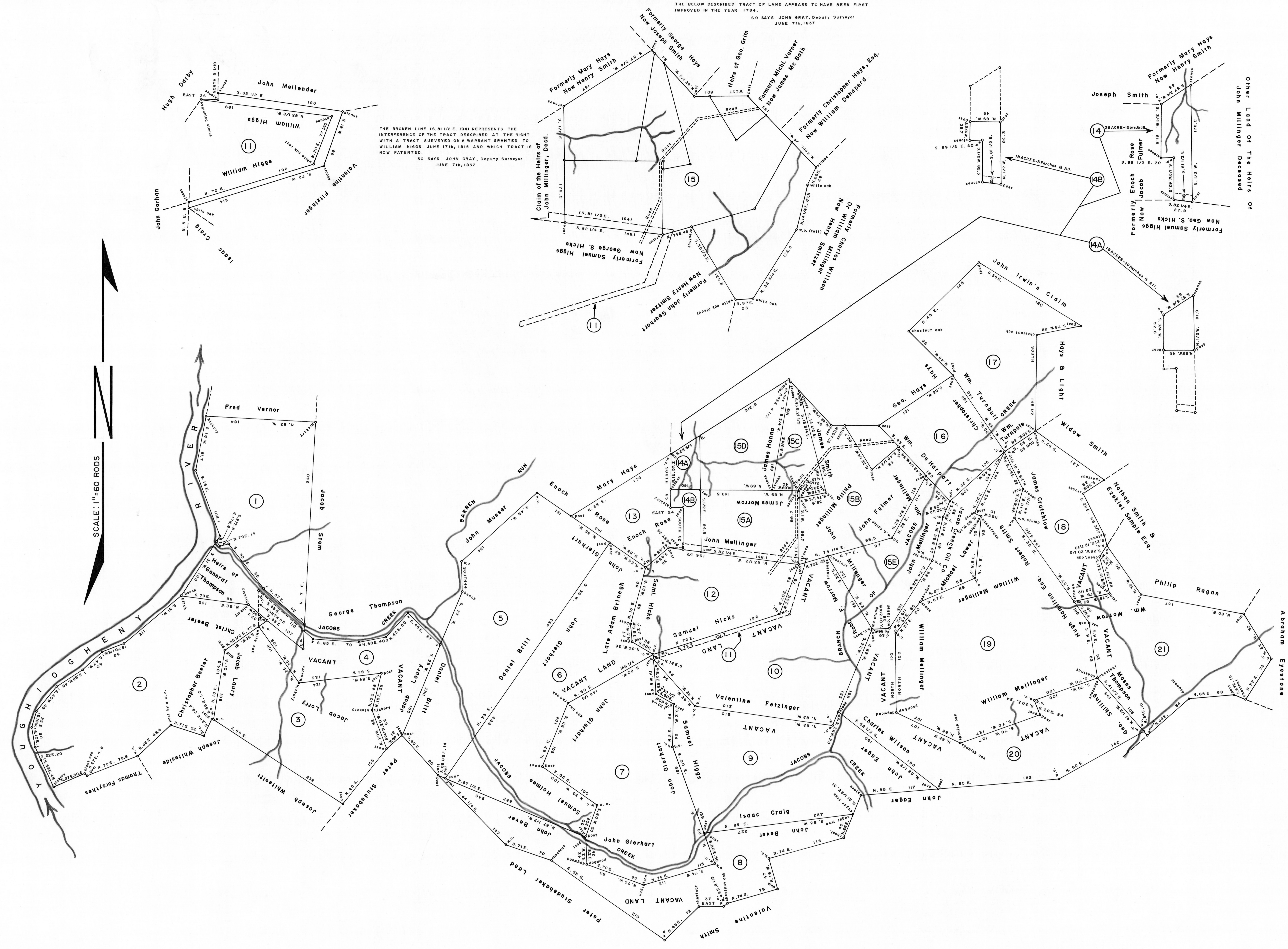

THE BELOW DESCRIBED TRACT OF LAND APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN FIRST IMPROVED IN THE YEAR 1784. SO SAYS JOHN GRAY, Deputy Surveyor JUNE 7th, 1837

THE BROKEN LINE (S. 81/2 E. 104) REPRESENTS THE INTERFERENCE OF THE TRACT DESCRIBED AT THE RIGHT WITH A TRACT SURVEYED ON A WARRANT GRANTED TO WILLIAM HIGGS JUNE 17th, 1815 AND WHICH TRACT IS NOW PATENTED. SO SAYS JOHN GRAY, Deputy Surveyor JUNE 7th, 1837
