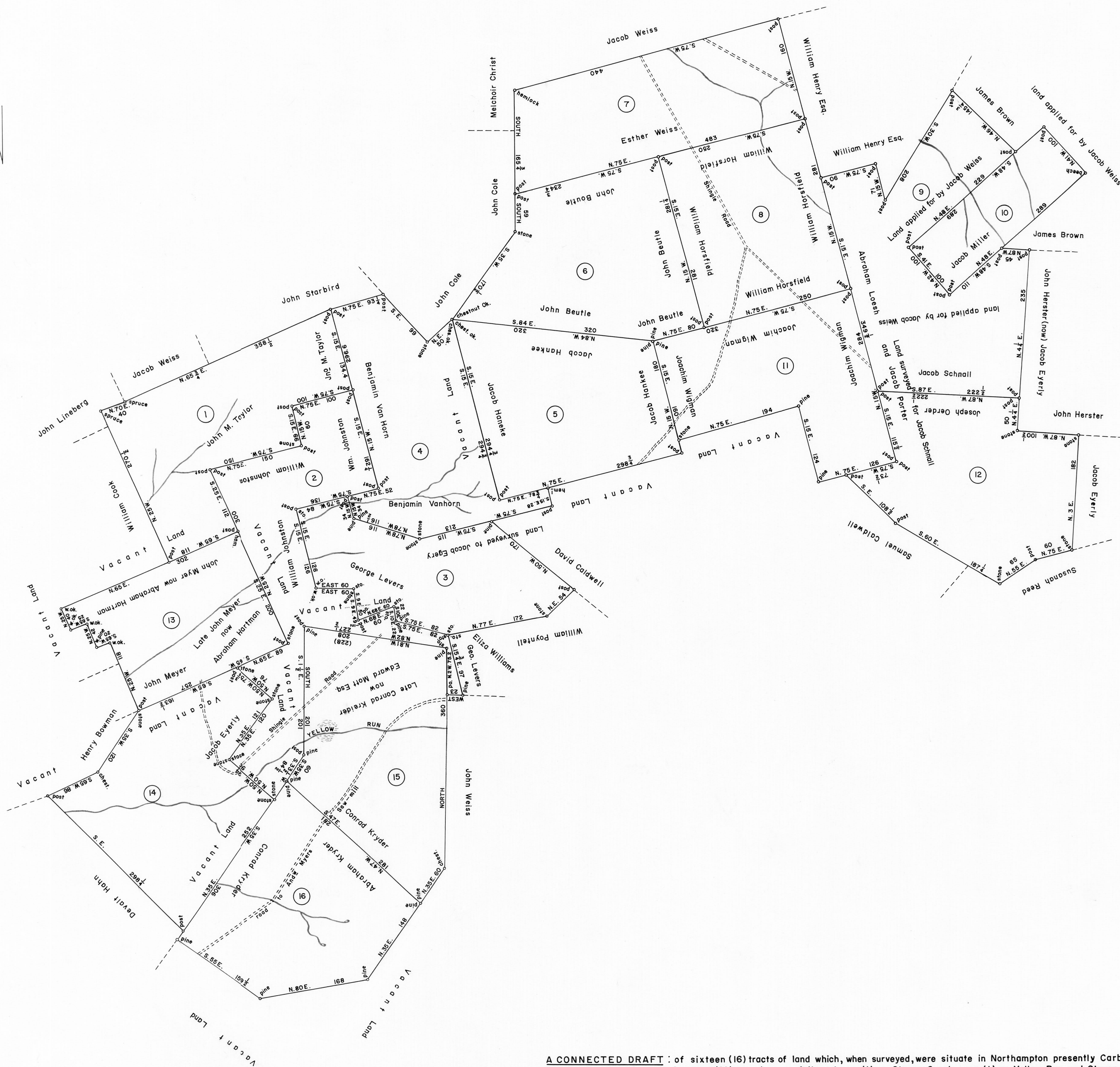

A CONNECTED DRAFT : of sixteen (16) tracts of land which, when surveyed, were situate in Northampton presently Carbon County; locations for only fourteen (14) are given as follows : one (1) on Stony Creek; one (1) on Yellow Run and Stony Creek; two (2) on Yellow Run; three (3) in Towamensing Township; and seven (7) on Muddy Run. The draft has been constructed from and compared with the original drafts on file in the Bureau of Land Records, Department of Internal Affairs, of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, under the direction of Anthony G. Reese, Director.
