A CONNECTED DRAFT of eighteen (18) tracts of land, which when surveyed, were situate as follows: six (6) in Barren Township, Bedford County; one (1) in Potters Township, Mifflin County; seven (7) in Ferguson Township, Centre County; one (1) in Ferguson and Jackson Townships, Centre and Huntingdon Counties; one (1) in Potter Township, Mifflin (now Centre) County; one (1) in Potters Township, Mifflin County, now Ferguson Township, Centre County; one (1) in Harris Township, Centre County. The draft has been constructed from and compared with the original drafts on file in the Bureau of Land Records, Department of Community Affairs, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, under the direction of Edward D. Price, Director.
