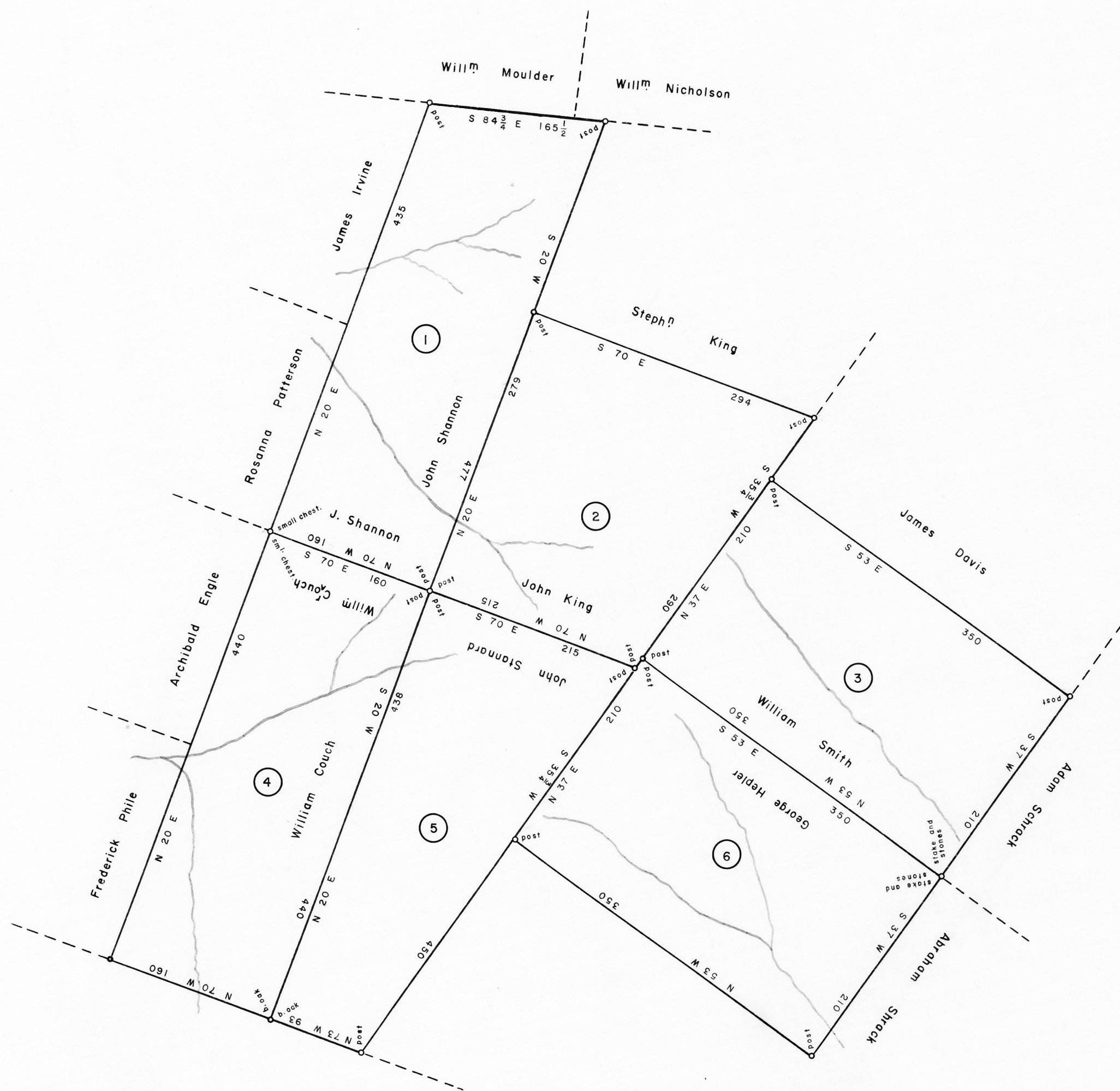


SCALE: 1" = 100 RODS
