seal of Henry H. Torey Esq directed to Joseph
Fremise Constable of the Borough of
McConnalsburg; was brought before me this day
Sarah a black woman of low stature and rather
under size, of the age of nineteen or twenty years
has a fair artificial look ~~stammer~~ when she
speaks particularly when agitated, also a black
female child of the said Sarah, aged twelve or
thirteen months, both claimed as the property
of the said Richard Morris -

George S. Morris of the City of Baltimore in the
State of Maryland: appeared (and being a disinterested
witness) was sworn according to law Deposed and
said that the said Sarah and child is the property
of Richard Morris of the City of Baltimore in the
State of Maryland, and absconded from the service of
of the said Richard some time in July last and by
the Laws of Maryland, the said Sarah and child
is slaves for life; the said Sarah being excommu-
-nated said she was the property of Richard Morris
and that she left the place where he had put her
out on hire - it therefore appearing to my satisfac-
-tion that the said Sarah and child is the property of
the said Richard Morris, I gave him a certificate
to remove her and child to the State of Maryland
