

This Indenture made the fifth Day of April in the
Year of our Lord One Thousand seven Hundred
and Eighty Eight. Nathaniel Pritchard Anthony Barton
of the Township of Bristol in the County of Bucks
Commonwealth of Pennsylvania have for my self my
Heirs Executors and Administrators manumitted and
set free and do by these Presents manumit and set free
the following Negroes Slaves to wit Negro Nancy and
Twenty seven years, Negro Susan aged Twenty four
years, Negro Peter aged Twenty two years, Negro Call
aged nineteen years, Negro Hannah aged fifteen years,
Negro Ruth aged thirteen years and Negro Isaac aged
Five years. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my
Hand and seal the Day and Year first above written

before me the Subscriber one of the Judges of
the Court of Common Pleas for the County of
Bucks personally appeared the above named Anthony
Barton and acknowledged the above Instrument of
Writing to be his Act and Deed, and desired the

To all People to whom these Presents shall come
Greeting know you that Patrick Colvin of the Township
of Falls in the County of Bucks and Commonwealth
of Pennsylvania Inkeeper have and do for my self my
Heirs Executors and Assigns Manumit and set
free my Negroes here named Samer about Twenty
seven years of Age, and I do hereby for my self my
Heirs Executors and Assigns resign and give up all my
Right Title and Interest to the said Negro Samer
from the Day of the Date of these Presents agreeable to
an Act of Assembly of this Commonwealth passed at
Philadelphia the first Day of March in the Year of
our Lord One Thousand seven Hundred and Eighty
Entituled an Act for the gradual Abolition of Slavery.
As Witness my Hand and seal this twenty ninth Day
of August in the Year of our Lord One Thousand
seven Hundred and eighty seven.
