Blacksmith, do hereby enter and return That Jonathan, a Mulatto Male
Child the Son of Negress Mintica a Female Slave, was born on
or about the Thirtieth Day of January in the Year of our Lord One
thousand Seven hundred and Ninety two, and that his said Mother
Mintica, was duly entered and registered by me at Lancaster as a
Slave, pursuant to the Act "For the gradual Abolition of Slavery"
and that the aforesaid Mulatto Child Jonathan is my Property and
liable to serve until it shall arrive to the Age of Twenty eight Years.
Witness my Hand the Thirtieth Day of April in the year of our Lord
One thousand Seven hundred and Ninety two
