Joseph Gentry of Washington County in Nottingham township miller enters a female negro child agreeably to law named Call and aged three years and seven months. Oath made before William Parker Esq. to the use &c. of the said child the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April 1789.

William Henry Town Noble of Robinson township farmer enters agreeably to law a male mulatto named Jack, born since 1<sup>st</sup> March 1788 and aged seven years. Oath made according to law by the said Noble the 1<sup>st</sup>
