James Black of Nottingham township merchant requests David Kedick to enter of records a male negro child named Solomon, aged four months & twenty one days the 2nd of August 1799 affidavit made before Daniel Phelps Esq entered the 3rd day of August 1799.

Andrew Poggis Esq of Hollowfields townships enters a negro female child named Lettie aged not more than five months this twenty sixth day of August 1799, Oath made according to law by A. Poggis 28th Aug 1799. David Kedick
