June 4th Mulatto Samuel Rivers lately from Maryland where he lived for about three years but was born in Wilming town, by occupation a Labourer residing now in strong gardens in the City of Lancaster, advanced Man taken for him self, Wife Ester son Charles and his wife Aunt Juliana Smith who reside with him

June 7th Negro Jacob Barry, aged about 24 years stout build five feet and 10 inches high with that hair was born in New London town which is in the County of Chester, came to this County about eleven months since is by occupation a Labourer, is a single man, resides with Peter Banett in this City

July 14th 1823 Negro Billy Downy, aged his age the count of hair in the Borough of York Pennsylvania skin black, all along the nose, small eyes, dark complexion, appeared about thirty years of age, single man, came to this land some time since, keeps his house with some others and near the carpenter in this City

July 17th 1823 Negro William Rockaway aged about 30 years born in New Jersey, in Middlesex County man married by his Master Isaac Smith of a dark complexion, stout build, resides with John Pinkerton of this City

July 21st 1823 Negro David Lee from Maryland some time since but lately from Market Forge aged above twenty five years of a dark complexion, stout build about five feet 8 1/2 inches high keeps his house at present at John Kauffman in this City, is a single man has no family

1823
August 11th Negro John Long lately from Harrisburg aged about 19 years his occupation a Labourer, hath been with doct. Hunselman but in Leeds, Exchange Street Lane and lives with William Croft in keeper in this City. Is of a dark complexion about five feet 10 inches high stout build, has no family unless that day for himself only

1824
March 30th Negro Henry Johnson, lately from Philadelphia aged 40 years the first of April next, by occupation a Chimney sweep, about five feet six inches high, stout build, clothes with Volens Voets of Calver & Town hall in the City of Lancaster, and is a single man, without a family

March 29th Negro James Bared, lately from Philadelphia, well made about five feet 7 or 8 inches high, by occupation a Labourer has this day got his name in deed for himself and wife Rebecca, residing in a house belonging to Thomas & Judson situated in the Alley between Queen Street and Duke Street, which said house he had purchased being aged about 22 years and his wife aged about the same age

March 31st 1824
Negro Calo Turner lately from Philadelphia dwelling here with a Freeman, aged about twenty two years, small figure dark complexion about five feet 7 inches high, single man, lives with Volens Voets in the City of Lancaster by occupation a Watcher

June 14th 1824 Mulatto John Rice lately from Philadelphia, aged about twenty years, by occupation a Chimney sweep, about five feet in five inches high, stout build, he declares that he was bound to Saml. Cutler of Calver a Chimney sweep, who died some time since, about five or six weeks, the said John lives in this City with Charles Gilmore and works for him at the business of sweeping Chimneys is a single man

July 19th 1824 Negro William Beck, who with he is lately from Harrisburg Pa. about 22 years of age, served his time with Amos Green, of Danforth, Dauphin County about 9 miles from Harrisburg. That he is a Freeman, has no family and by occupation a Labourer is about five feet 8 inches high, neck knotted, skin more his complexion not very dark, resides with Miss Simpson in King Street Lancaster
