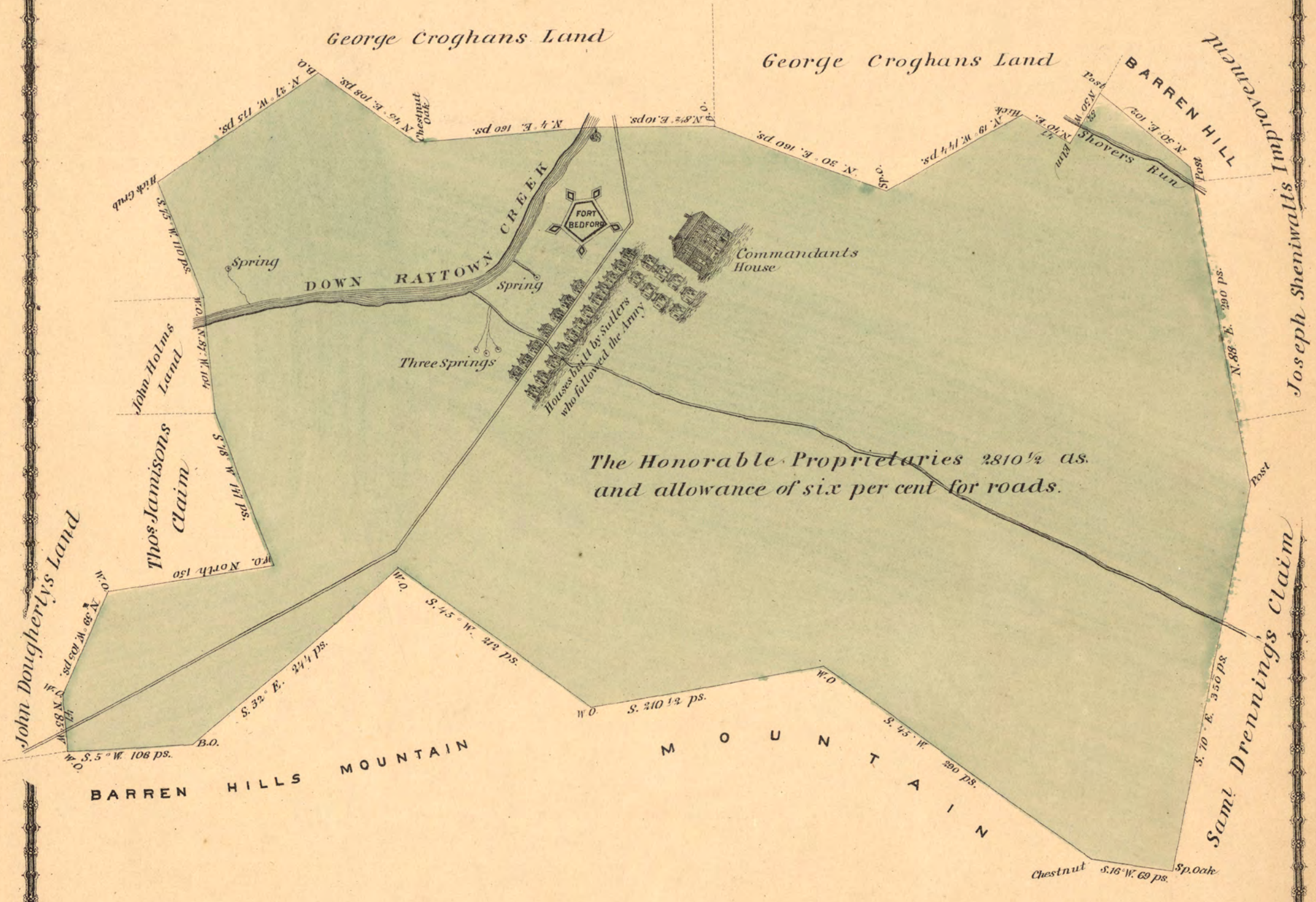


PROPRIETARIES GRANT.



A draught of a tract of land situated at Bedford, in the County of Cumberland, containing two thousand, eight hundred and ten acres and an half of one acre, with the usual allowance of six per cent. for roads; Surveyed for the Honorable the Proprietaries, the 29th day of October, 1761, in pursuance of a warrant bearing date the twenty-fifth day of November, one thousand seven hundred and forty-eight,—1747.
