The unpaid offers made by the Board and from which
 no appeals appear to have been taken amount to \$ 37. 890. 38 1/2
 They are dates from the 10th July 1830 to the 20 March 1832.

As there is no limitation of time to the right of appealing to the
 Board of appraisers by claimants who are dissatisfied with the offer
 of the Canal Commissioners, the above sum may include offers from
 which appeals will be taken and does include some ^{offers to} ~~which~~ ^{who} are stated
 by the Superintendent to be dissatisfied with the amount offered by the
 Canal Commissioners. But until the appeal is actually taken to the
 appraisers there is no law by which they have the right of demanding
 the payment of the offer and hence the offers unpaid and unappealed
 from, are considered to be liens under the provisions of the Law.
