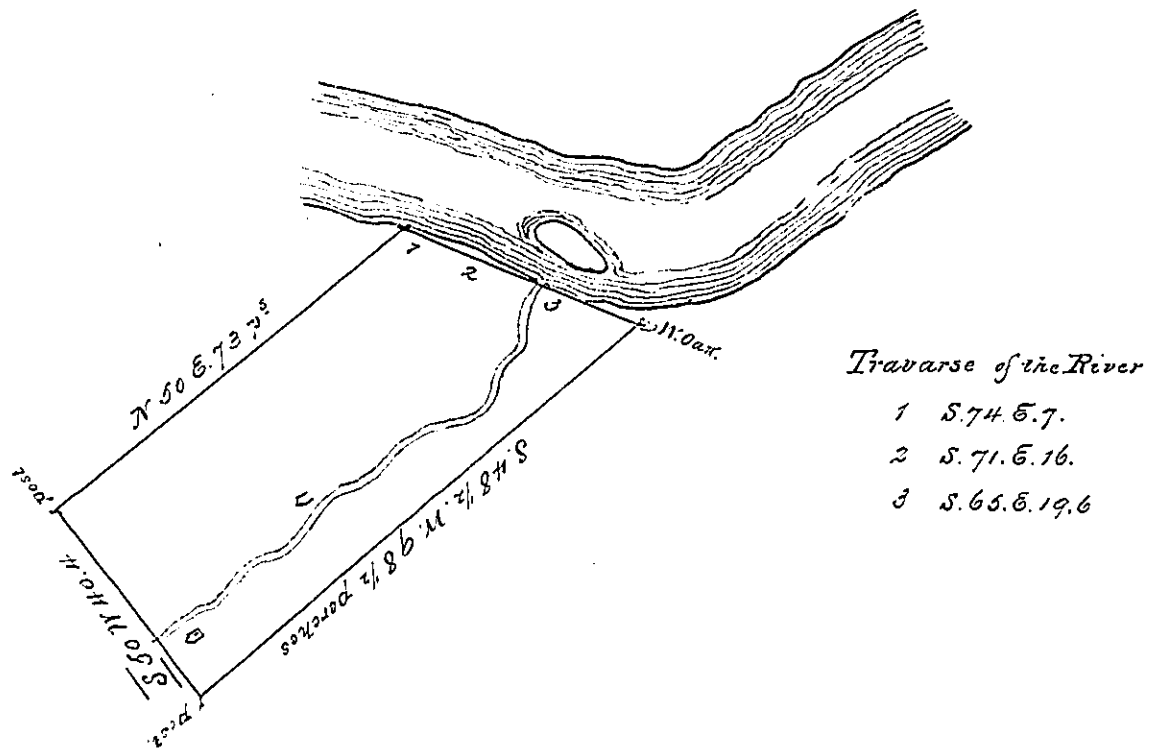


Scale 80 parts to the Inch



A draft of a tract of land situate on and including a small stream called Landing creek or Little Towandy including also the line between the Township of Wyatcing and the Township of Towandy in the County of Luzerne and also including a Gristmill erected and an improvement made in the year 1791 by Stephen Duval containing twenty acres with allowance of six per centum for roads. Surveyed for Samuel Baird Agent for the Asylum Company in pursuance of a Warrant in the name of Stephen Duval dated the 13<sup>th</sup> day of August A.D. 1792.
