



Situate on the West side of French Creek in Allegheny County containing 401 Acres 150 perches, and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. resurveyed the 10th day of July 1799. in pursuance of a Warrant of 400 acres granted to John Eby bearing date the 30th day of May 1792 - it being the same tract of land which was surveyed the 28th October 1794 for James Culbertson on his Improvement dated the 27th October 1794

I Ebenezer Feltton Deputy Surveyor of Crawford County certify that the above is a true copy of the entry of Surveys remaining in my office and that the land is situated in Crawford County in what is now the township of Fallonsfield - October 29 1834
