



The Above is a Draught of a Survey made October 15<sup>th</sup> 1787 Call<sup>d</sup> Nupps Bottom Containing 295 Acres Surveyed in pursuance of the annex'd Certificate viz - We the Commissioners for adjusting Claims to Unpatented Land in the County of Monongalia, Yohogania and Ohio do hereby Certify that Everhart Nupp is entitled to three hundred acres of Land in the County of Monongalia on ten Mile Creek to Include his Actual Settlement made in the year one Thousand seven hundred & sixty nine also a Right to a Preemption to one thousand acres adjoining thereto -
