

The above is a draught of a Tract of land on the waters of Robinsons Run Washington County called Millmount containing 398 Acre 3 Rods & 22 perches Surveyed by Virtue of a Virginia Certificate in these words
 viz: We the Commissioners appointed to adjust claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongalia Yohogania & Ohio do hereby certify that James Ering is Entitled to four hundred Acres of land in the County of Yohogania on the waters of Robinsons Run to include his Settlement made in the year of Our Lord 1773. also a right of preemption to one Thousand acres of land adjoining thereto
 Given under our hands at Copley fort. 23rd Feb'y 1780. in the fourth year of the Commonwealth
