



In Virtue of a Warrant of the 4 Day of September last past, Surveyed to Paul Reeser the following Tract of Land, Situate in the Townsh^{ip} of Durham in the County of Bucks, Beginning at an heap of Stones Corner of the said Reeser's other land, & thence extend^d by the same North ~~West~~ 52 1/2 Per^{cent} to a Post thence by the land of John Schack ~~South~~ East 32 1/2 Per^{cent} to another Post thence by vacant land, South ~~East~~ 52 1/2 Per^{cent} to an heap of Stone by ~~South~~ West 32.4 P to the Beginning containing 10^a with allowance at 6th Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed 9th 14th 1749.
