



Situate on the west side of French Creek in Allegheny County containing 401 acres 150 P's and allowance of six per cent for roads be Resurveyed the 12th July 1799 in pursuance of a warrant of 400^{ac} granted to Andrew Eppole bearing date the 30th May 1792 1st. It being the same track of land which was surveyed the 6th November 1794 for Peter Dunn on his Improvement dated the 5th November 1794.

I do certify that the above is a true copy of a survey as it stands stated of record remaining in my office now situate in Fallowfield Township of Crawford County ^{excepting} the line of division which was surveyed and marked between Amos Ales and Joseph Clarke the 4th day of July 1817.
