



Situate on the Waters of Big Branch Creek in Union Township Huntingdon County containing two Hundred and Eighty four acres and allowance of six per Cent Surveyed for Matthew Irwin on order No. 543 dated the 1st Day of August 1766.

The dotted lines represent part of a survey made for Amos Clark on Warrant dated the 2nd Day of January 1795. This survey interferes three acres and sixty perches with the Matthew Irwin survey. Amos Clark conveyed to Samuel Meredith whose heirs now claim the same To Jacob Spangler Esq. D. C. Daniel Africa D. S.
