



Situate in Greenwood Township, Columbia County, surveyed by William Montgomery Esq. Deputy Surveyor on the 19th day of November 1796 unto Christian Wertz, by virtue of his warrant bearing date the 16th day of August 1773, and now to wit on the 5th day of March 1823. Resurveyed for Joseph Cavence by virtue of an order of Resurvey bearing date the 25th day of February 1823, according to the original lines, containing two hundred ninety six acres and forty seven perches and the usual allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c. - by
