



In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th of June 1822 a survey was made on the 3^d of July 1823 of a certain lot of Ground in the Town of Cumberland in the County of Northumberland numbered in the general plan of said Town, Fifty nine containing in Breadth North and South, Fifty seven feet six Inches and in length East and West Two hundred and thirty feet bounded westward by Broad Way, Northward by Lot number Fifty eight, Eastward by River alley and Southward by Lot number Sixty, as by the general plan of said Town remaining in the Surveyor Generals Office will appear
