



A draught of a tract of land situate one mile north of Bowmans creek including a large Beaver meadow and part of a Pond on a ~~bran~~ branch of the same creek in the Township of Braintree and County of Luzerne containing four hundred and six acres and sixty two perches and allowance of six per cent for roads. said to have been surveyed the 5 day of June 1794 in pursuance of a warrant in the name of Thomas Sharp dated the 28th day of August 1792. By an examination on the ground the 16th day of September 1811 the survey is found to have been made and the lines and corners well marked
