



Surveyed on the 21st Day (1733) to Peter Shilbert a Tract of Land situate in Oley in the County of Philadelphia Beginning at a hickery being a Corner of Nicholas Fishers land thence by the same South West twenty eight Perches to a post thence by other Land of s^d Shilbert North West one hundred & twenty Perches to a post thence by Nicholas Englehart's Land North East twenty two perches to a post thence by Land of Engle Peters South East sixteen perches to a post thence by the s^d Engle Peters Land North East six perches to a Post thence by Nicholas Fishers Land South East one hundred & four perches to ye place of Beginning Containing twenty acres with usual Allowance
