



Surveyed to James Campbell on the 26th Nov^r 1767th the above described tract of three hundred & eighty eight acres and allowance of six per Cent. Situate on the north side of Conemaugh River, adjoining John Donachy & his other land in Westmoreland County. By virtue of Two warrants the one dated the 18th March & the other the 5th Dec^r 1776.

That part of the above Survey represented by the shaded lines and the letters A. B. was surveyed to Samuel Waddle on the 7th June 1769 By order of the 3rd April 1769. No. 2528. The land is patented upon James Campbell Survey and is owned by Robert Brown of Greensburgh in Westmoreland County in whose hands the patent is, ascertained the above interference 19. Dec^r 1827.
