



A Draught of a tract of Land Situate in Maccungy Township in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania. Being part of a tract of sixty acres of Bartholomew Hubers land, Beginning at a stone, on the line of Adam Dash late Jacob Wagners land, thence by the same South 16 degrees East 38 perches to a stone, thence by Stephen Wonders land South 46 degrees West 100 perches to a stone, thence by Andrew Trexlers and John Trexlers North 50 degrees West 21 perches to a stone thence by the said John Trexlers land North 40 degrees East 25 perches to a stone and North West 22 perches to a stone, thence by the said Bartholomew Huber's other land North East fifty seven perches to a stone, thence by land of Jacob Wagner late Conrad Kolbs, North 65 degrees East 40 perches to the place of Beginning, Containing twenty five acres and 127 perches of land together with the usual allowance, at six per Cent for Roads. Surveyed and Divided for the said Bartholomew Huber on the 20 Day of November Anno 1762.
