



By Virtue of a warrant from the Hon^{ble}. Proprietaries bearing Date the Eleventh Day of March Anno D^o 1740. I have Surveyed and Laid out unto Christopher Slegle on Collingtons run in the County of Lancaster on the West Side Susquehanna River four hundred and thirty five Acres of Land with allowance of six P. Out. Beginning at a white Oak Thence North fifty four Degrees Westward one hundred and twelve perches to a Black Oak Thence North thirty six Degrees Eastward three hundred and ten perches to a Post Thence South fifty four Degrees Eastward two hundred and sixty ⁽⁶⁶⁾ perches to a Hickory Thence South thirty six Degrees Westward two hundred and sixteen perches to a Post Thence North seventy six Degrees Westward one hundred and seven ⁽⁷⁵⁾ perches to a Maple Thence South thirty six Degrees ⁽³⁶⁾ Westward thirty perches to an Elm Thence North seventy eight Degrees Westward fifty perches to the place Beginning.
