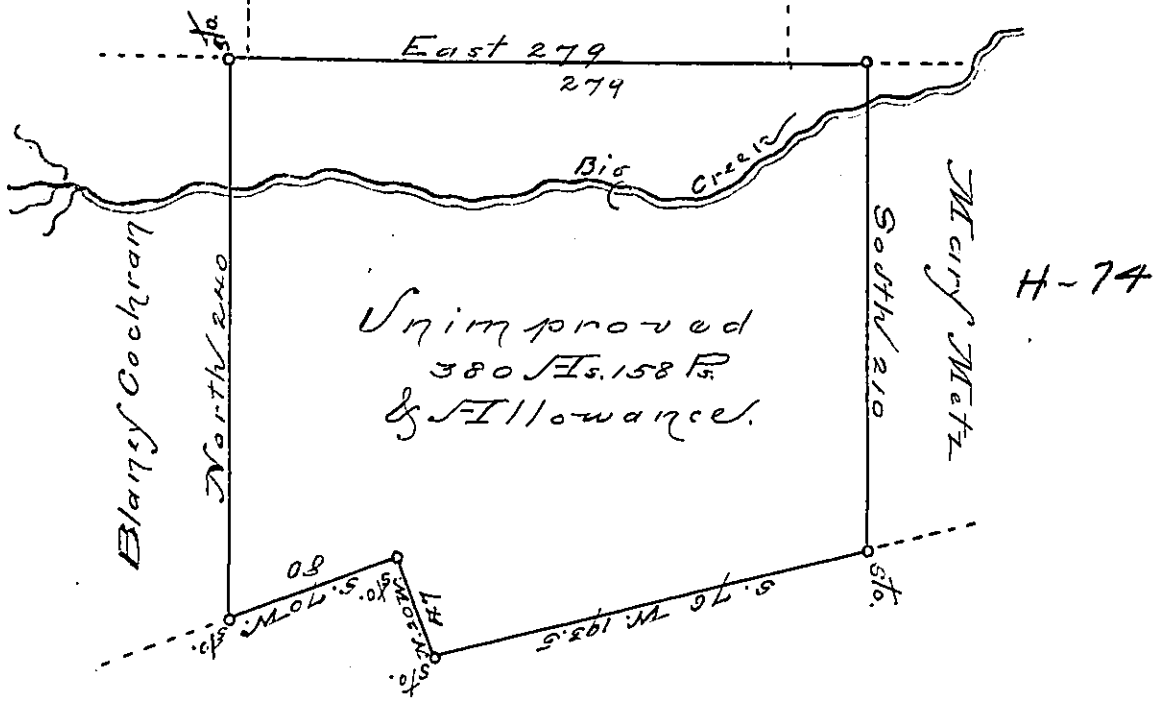

Situates in Schuylkill township Schuylkill County containing three hundred and eighty acres and one hundred and fifty eight perches and the allowance of six per cent, said to have been surveyed on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of May 1794 in Pursuance of a warrant dated the 19<sup>th</sup> November 1793 granted Rachel Jennings as appears by an official copy of the return of survey made into the Surveyor General's office, Resurveyed on the 9<sup>th</sup> September 1826 in Pursuance of an order of the Board of Property dated the 30<sup>th</sup> March 1826.
