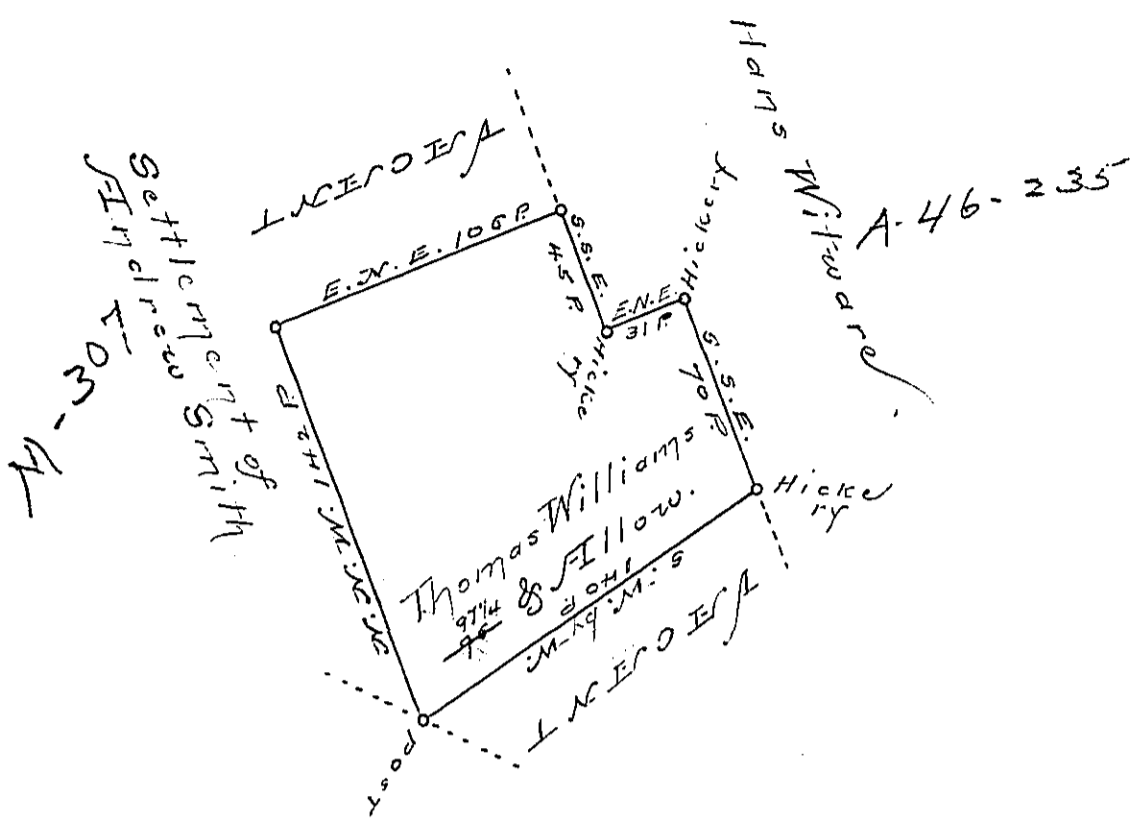


Set out - Brecknock Twp.



By Virtue of <sup>two</sup> a Warrants Dated the first Day of July A.D. 1743 The above Described Tract of Land was Surveyed unto Thomas Williams in Esler township in Lancaster County the 16<sup>th</sup> of August Anno Dom 1744 and contains ninety <sup>seven and a quarter</sup> ~~six~~ acres beside of all of 6 P. Cent.

A Warrant dated 15<sup>th</sup> June 1738 for 50<sup>As.</sup> but N.W. not complying re. by Warrant of 1<sup>st</sup> July 1743 the Survey was ordered to be made for Thos. Williams. 1<sup>st</sup> July 1743 T. Williams another Warrant for 50<sup>As.</sup> adjoining the above. Thomas Williams assigned his Rights to both 4<sup>th</sup> P. Warrant to Jacob Sensing.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833. I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this
