



I surveyed on the twenty seventh day of Feb^r. 1733 to Moses Starr a certain tract of land
 situated on a branch of the River Skunk called Hundwicheles in the County of
 Philad^a. Beginning at a post being a Corner of Nehemiah Huttons land thence by — same
 South Seventy Degrees East one hundred forty nine perches to a post another Corner of the
 said Huttons land thence by Vacant land ^{South East one hundred & 60 perches to a post thence by Vacant land} South West three hundred and five perches to a post
 thence by Vacant land North West three hundred and sixty perches to a post in the line of
 Jeremiah Starrs land thence by the same North Sixty degrees East two hundred
 fifty one perches to the place of beginning containing five hundred and
 fifty ^{one} acres with usual Allowance.
