



The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 27th Day of October 1795 In Pursuance of a Certificate granted by the Commissioners Appointed to settle the Claims of unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongalia, Yohogania and Ohio.

Amos Robins heir at law of Joel Robins, Deceased, which Certificate I find entered with William Crawford Surveyor of Yohogania County on the 29th Day of March 1780.

Situated on the waters of Chanters Creek in Washington County Containing one Hundred and fifty three Acres, Strict Measure Called Canton.
