



In pursuance of a warrant for 400 acres dated the 30<sup>th</sup> day of May A.D. 1792 granted to Francis West was surveyed on the twelfth day of June 1817.

The above described tract of land containing 395 acres 124 perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. situated in Bloomfield Township, Crawford County, and at the time of making the same, \_\_\_\_\_ was residing thereon, and there was built a house fit for the habitation of man, and there appeared to be upwards of twelve acres of the land cleared, fenced and in a state of cultivation, and that the same was divided as does ~~stated, between~~
