Whereas by Direction of the Honorable Proprietaries there was shewed unto Nicholas Shaffer a certain Lot of Ground situate in the Town of York in the County of York marked in the general Plan of the said Town Number Two hundred & eleven.

Now in Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 23<sup>d</sup> day of September 1762, requiring me to accept the said Survey so made of the said Lot of Ground, and make Return thereof into the Secretaries Office in order for Confirmation by Patent to the said Nicholas Shaffer, I do hereby certify the said Lot to be situate in the said Town & County of York & on the West Side of George Street, containing in Breadth on said Street fifty seven feet & six Inches, & in Length Two hundred & fifty feet - Bounded Northward by Lot Number Two hundred and ten, Eastward with George Street aforesaid, Southward by Lot Number Two hundred & twelve, & Westward by a twenty feet alley. Returned into the Secretaries Office the 24<sup>th</sup> day of September 1762.
