



A Draught of a Tract of land situate in Berwick Township in the County of York. Resurveyed the 13<sup>th</sup> day of May by the Old lines to Nicholas Bittinger in pursuance of a Warrant to Nicholas Shores Dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of October 1751, Containing Forty Eight Acres and Six Eighths and allowance of six acres P. Cent. for Roads & N.B. The piece where the Letter E stands is included in Conrad Doll's Draught on a Warrant for 25<sup>th</sup> granted to Frederick Shulla by the name of Frederick Jollay Dated the 4<sup>th</sup> day of April 1754. It is Probable that the Parties will Dispute this before the Board, Doll's Draught is Returned.
