



By Virtue of an Application No 2484 dated the 8<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1767, entered by Peter Kreitzer there was afterwards in the same year surveyed unto him the above described tract of land situate in (then Berks now) Schuylkill County over the 3<sup>d</sup> Mountain on the main branch of Sweetard Creek containing 320<sup>a</sup> 80<sup>p</sup> & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Now surveyed unto George Kreitzer on the 17<sup>th</sup> of August A.D. 1813 By
