I then went to search for a line, but could not find any, so continued the course 179^{Ps} farther where I found a B.O. thence I continued round the whole and found it to contain as above. Coner expects to have his warrant filed out if not the whole 72 & 15^d. your Judge by seeing the Draughts.
